Bukhara, New Delhi

The iconic New Delhi eatery, <code>Bukhara</code>, took the 45th spot on the list. This restaurant is located inside the grand <code>ITC Maurya</code> hotel in Chanakyapuri. Known for its famous Dal Bhukhara, this restaurant re-entered the list of top 50 restaurants in Asia after a span of few years. It is said that the core dishes served at the Bukhara haven't changed in over 40 years. And the man behind the success of this restaurant is none other than Head Chef JP Singh. Besides the dal, Bukhara also serves some delicious tandoori kebabs and their signature style is to provide patrons with no cutlery, so that the food is enjoyed with your hands and mouth.

Asia's 50 best restaurants 2020 list was announced virtually on Tuesday, March 24, 2020. Generally, a grand ceremony is organised during the presentation of this list. However, due to the <u>coronavirus outbreak</u>, the list was presented via live videos on YouTube and Facebook. On Asia's 50 Best Restaurants 2020 list, only two eateries were Indian.
